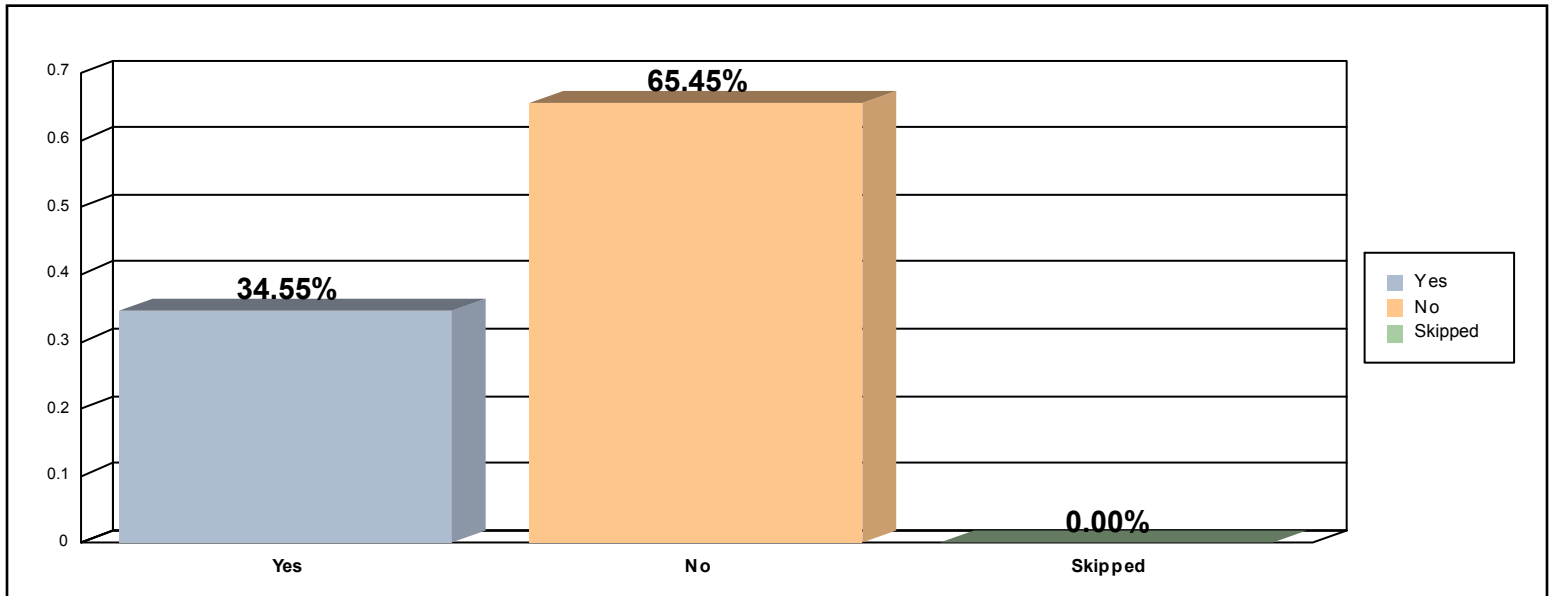

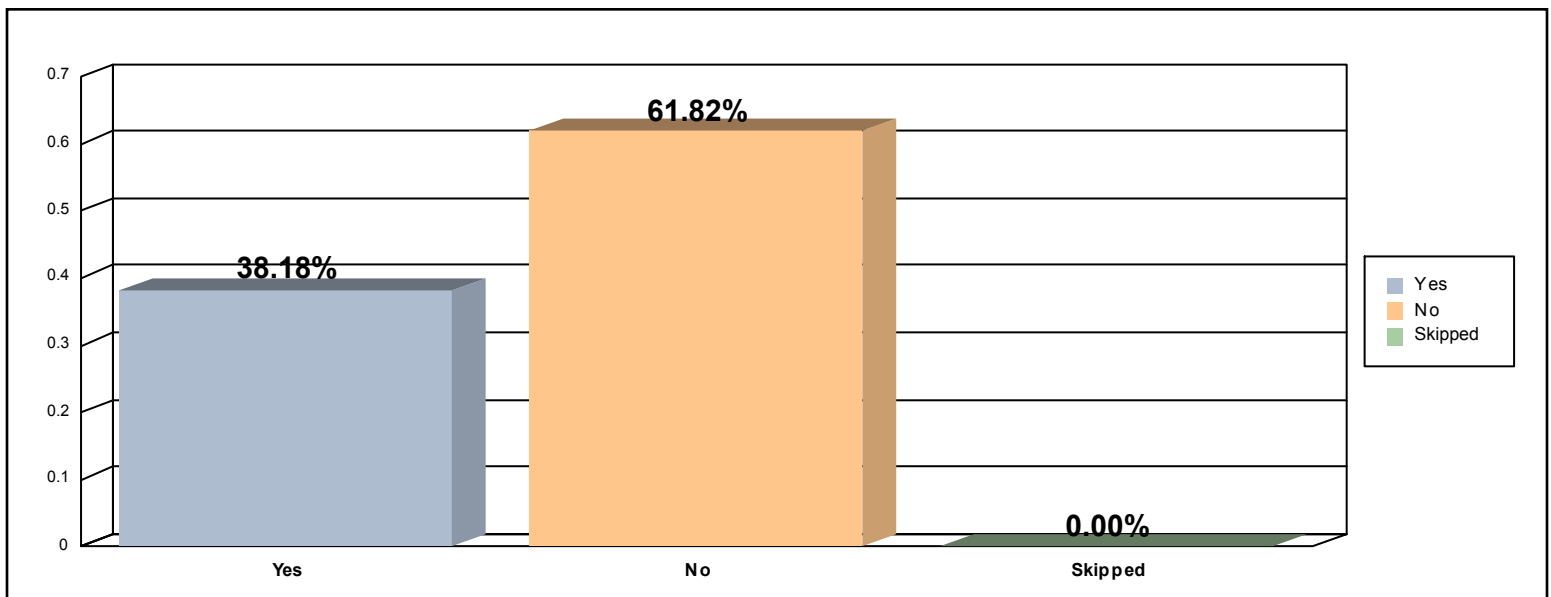

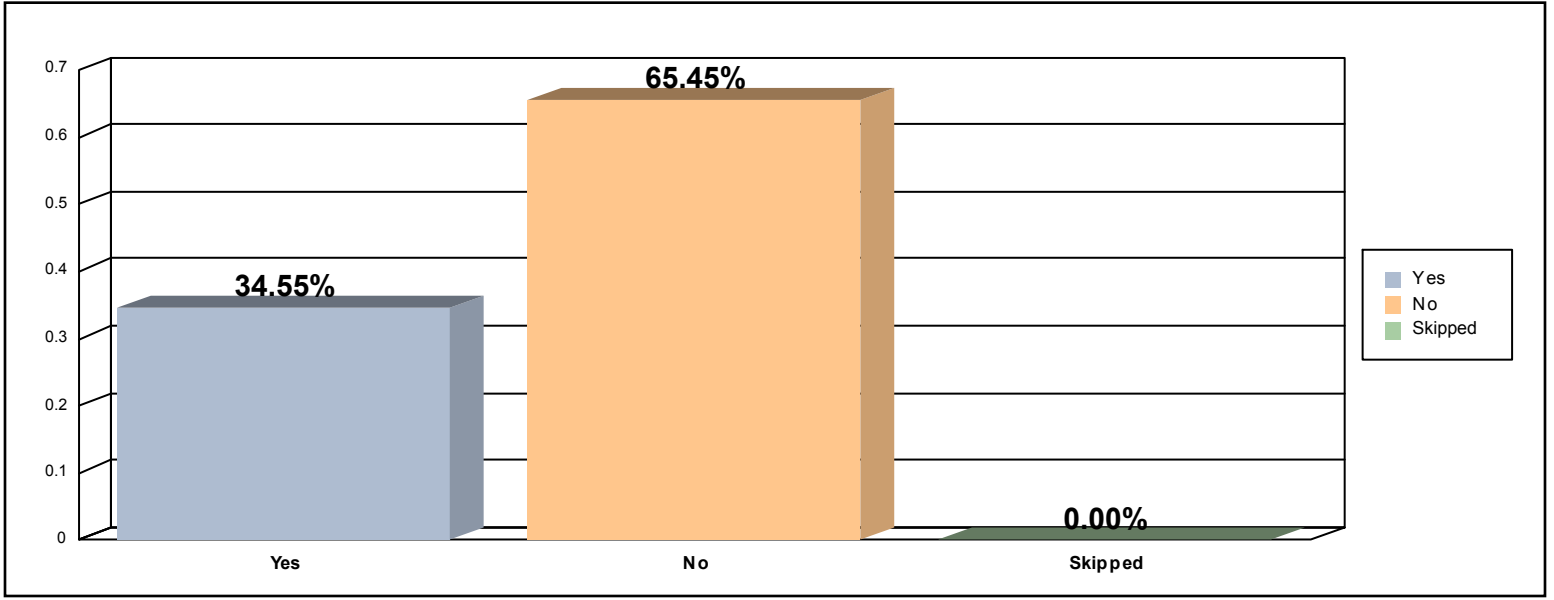
1. House Bill 11, the Keep Powering Pennsylvania Act, proposes supporting nuclear energy production in the Commonwealth at a cost of about \$500 million per year to prevent Three Mile Island Nuclear Facility from closing for at least six more years. The residential ratepayer-funded cost would be about \$1.77 per month and industrial rates would be significantly higher. Do you favor providing ratepayer funding to TMI?



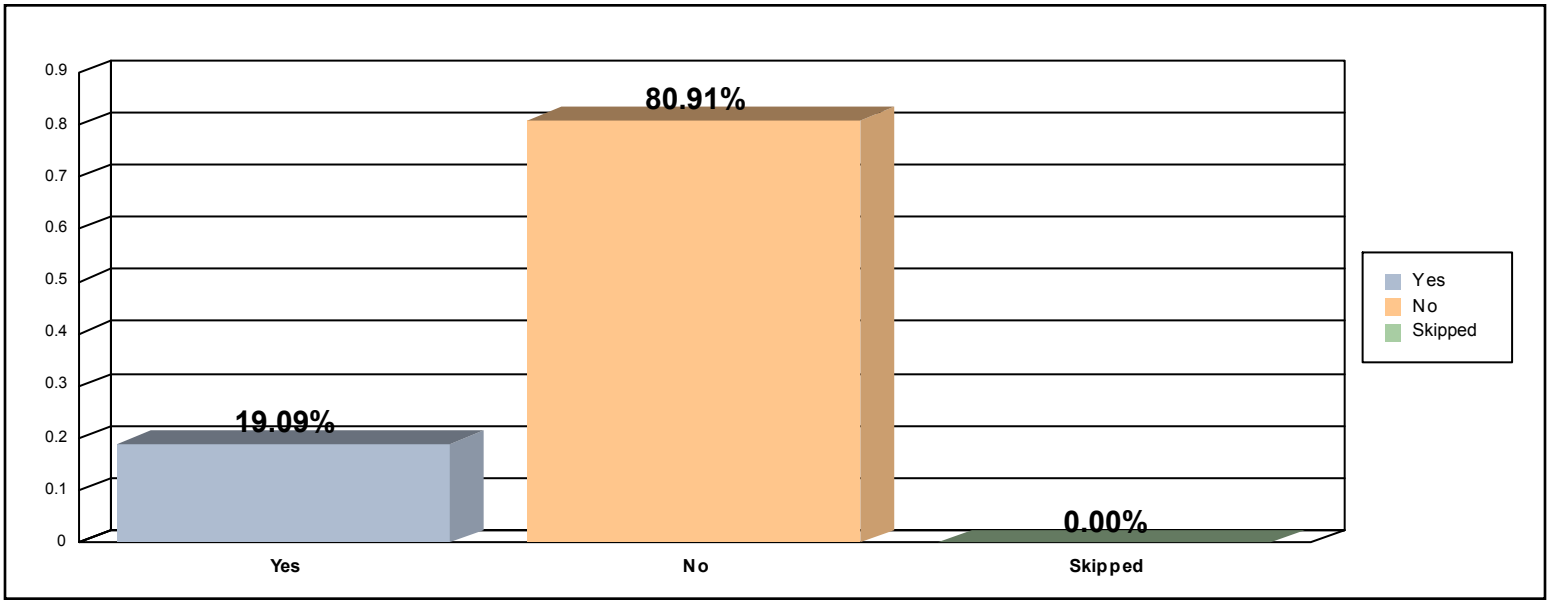
2. The Senate is considering a bill to expand what animals are allowed to be hunted on Sundays. Do support this expansion of hunting on Sundays?



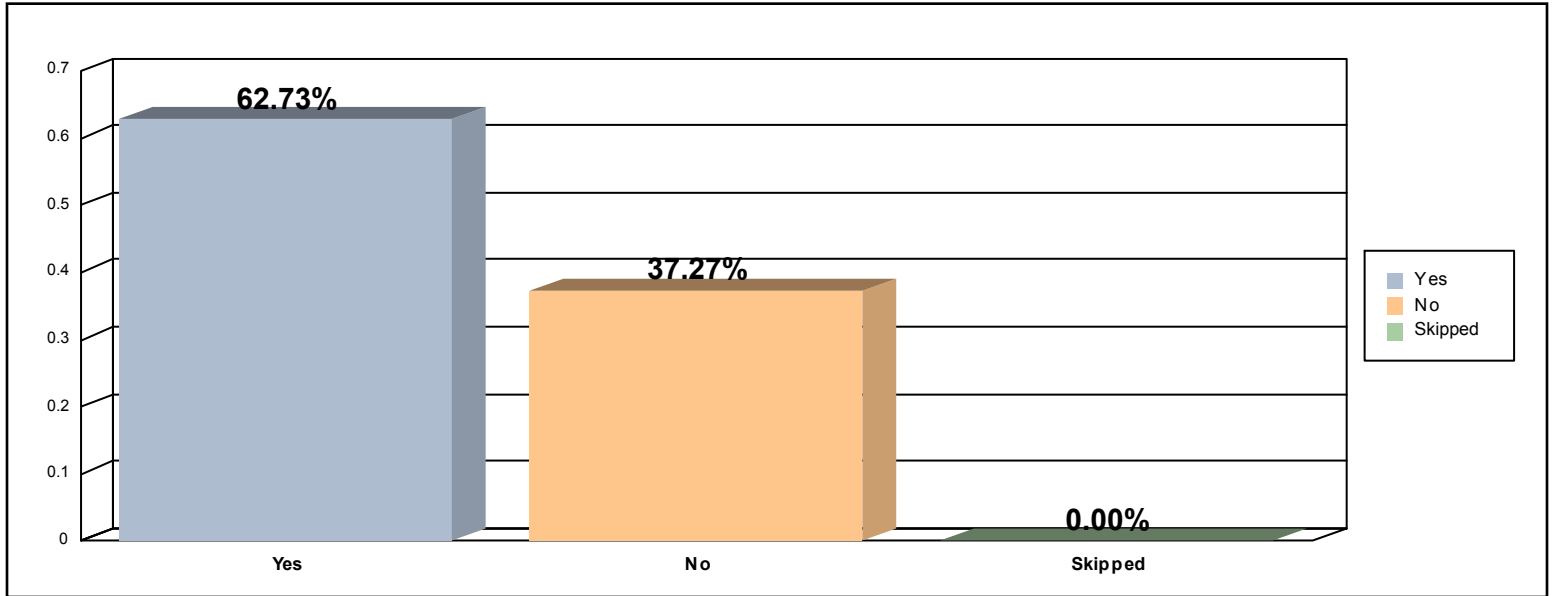
3. The governor is once again calling for a government mandated minimum wage increase in the Commonwealth. He is calling for a \$15 per hour minimum wage. Do you favor increasing the minimum wage?



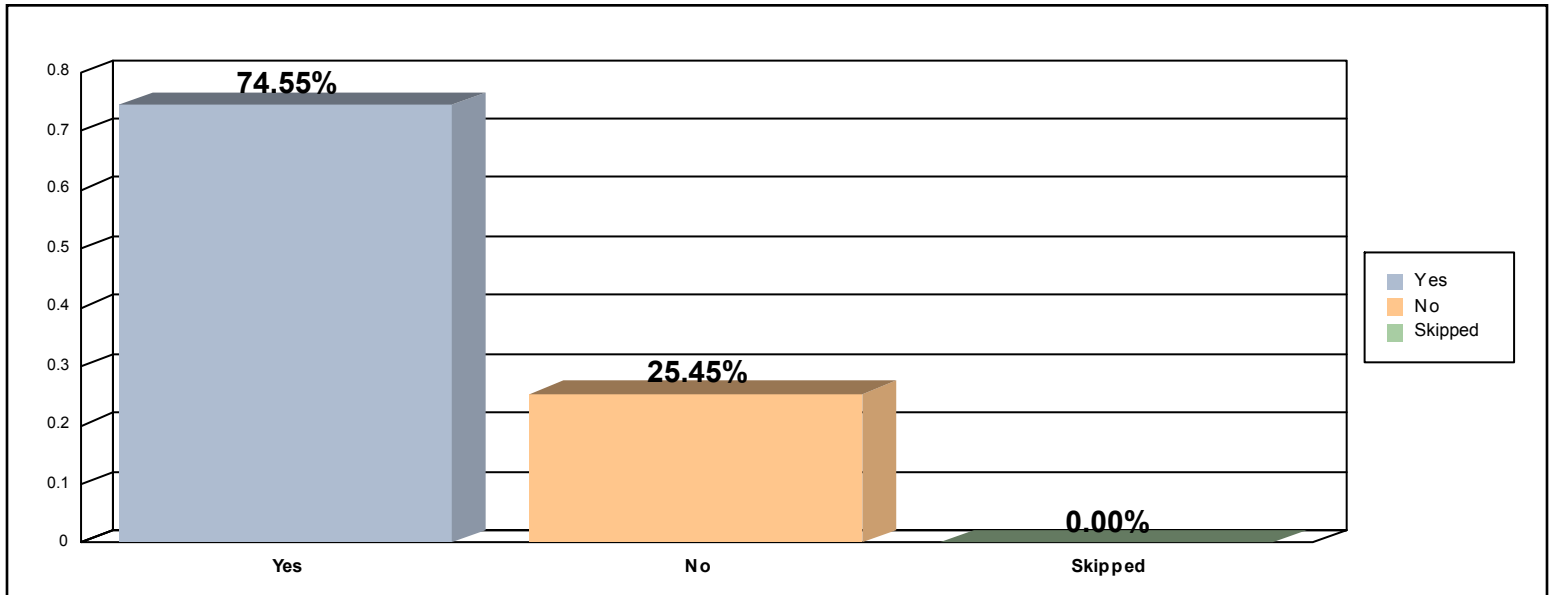
4. House Bill 768, would require all gun owners to register themselves and each firearm they own with the Pennsylvania State Police (PSP). Firearms would have to be registered yearly at a cost of \$10 per gun, on top of providing detailed personal information to the PSP including citizenship status and fingerprinting. Do you favor this statewide registry?



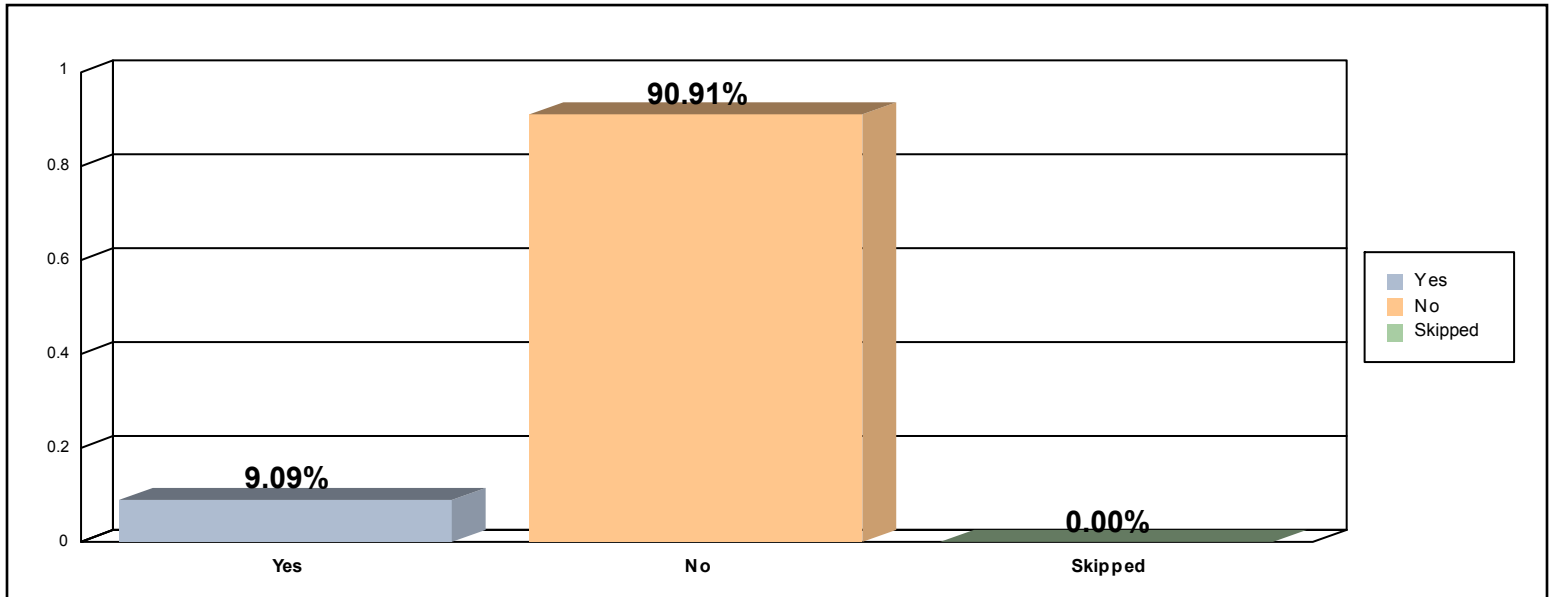
5. The Taxpayer Relief Act allows school districts to propose a referendum during every municipal election . to provide property relief for homeowners up to 100% of the assessed value of your home. It would be funded through an increased local Earned Income Tax (EIT) or converting the current EIT to a Personal Income Tax (PIT) and increasing the PIT rate. Do you support your local school district placing this option on the ballot for voter approval?



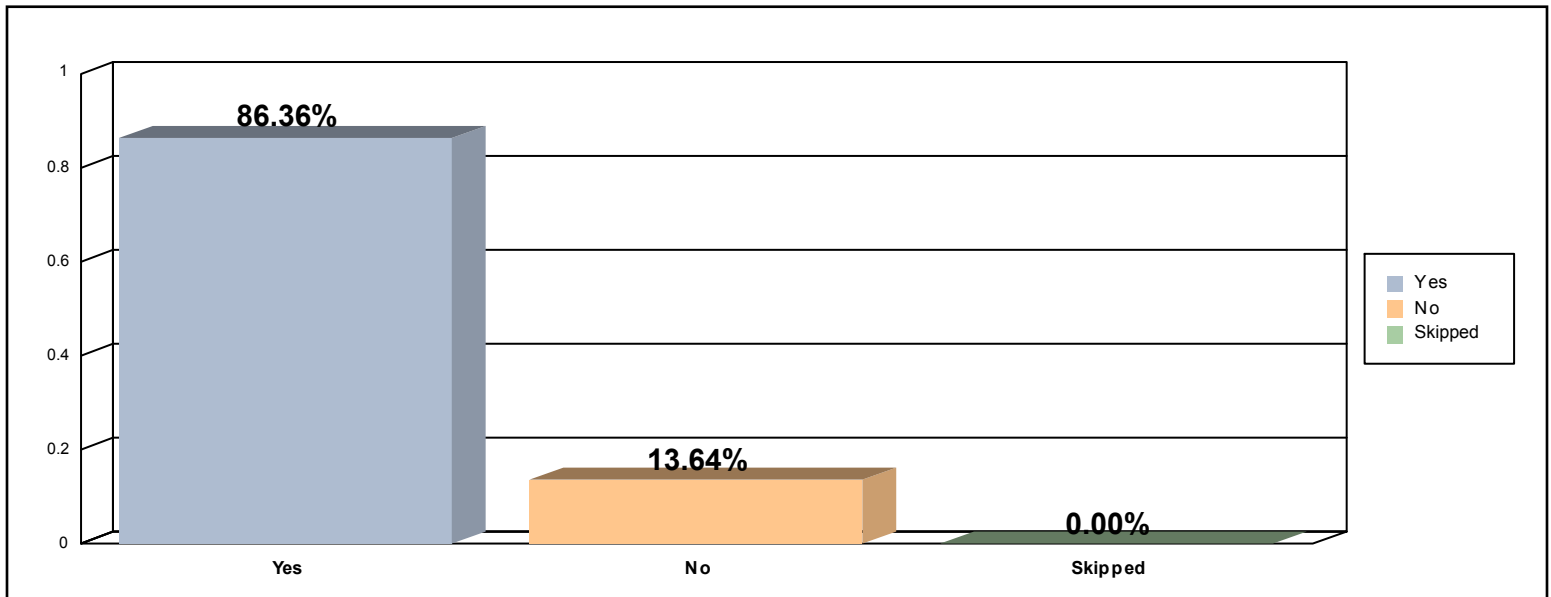
6. Are you aware Rep. Grove is actively keeping constituents updated on state issues with his Facebook page and Twitter page?



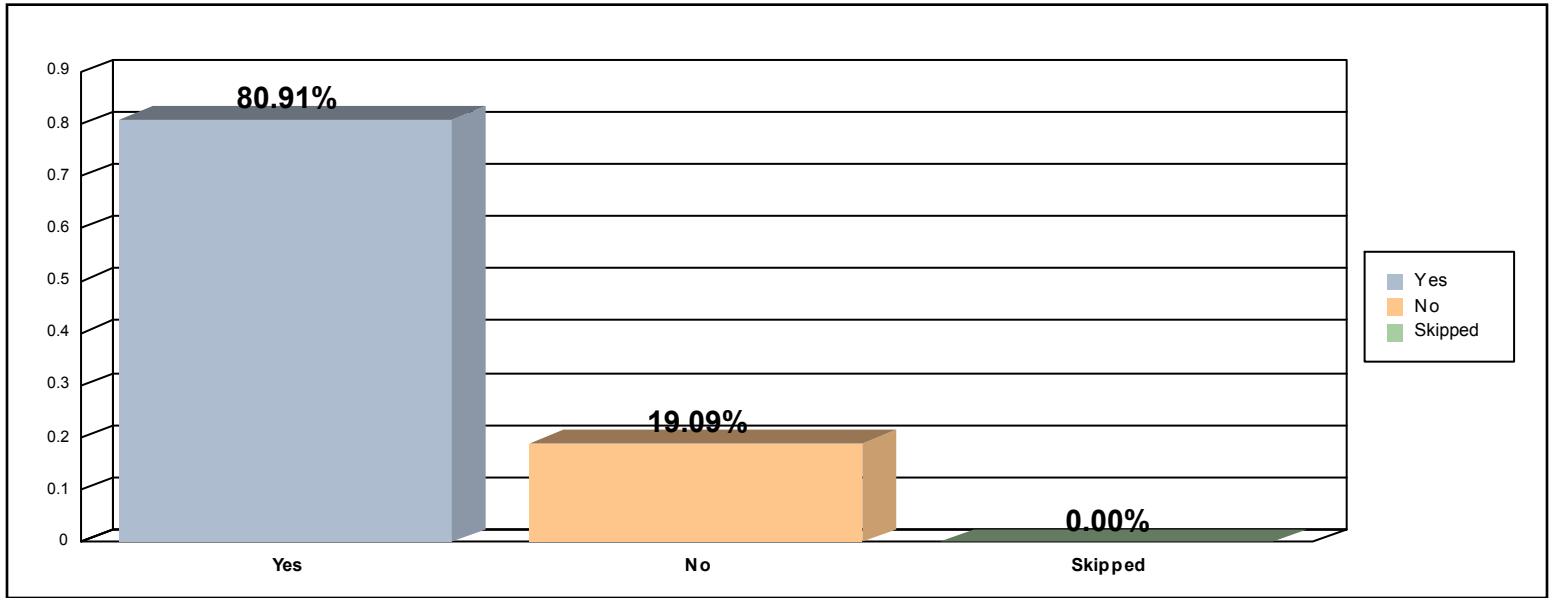
7. Have you visited Rep. Grove's district office, at 2501 Catherine St., for assistance in a state related matter?

10. This year, the House of Representatives created a Government Oversight Committee to conduct fact-based, bipartisan oversight on executive agencies and executive actions. Rep. Grove was named the inaugural chair of the committee. For the first time in the history of the General Assembly, this position was elected by the members of the committee and not through an appointment process. Do you support this approach of fact-based, bipartisan oversight on executive agencies?
