

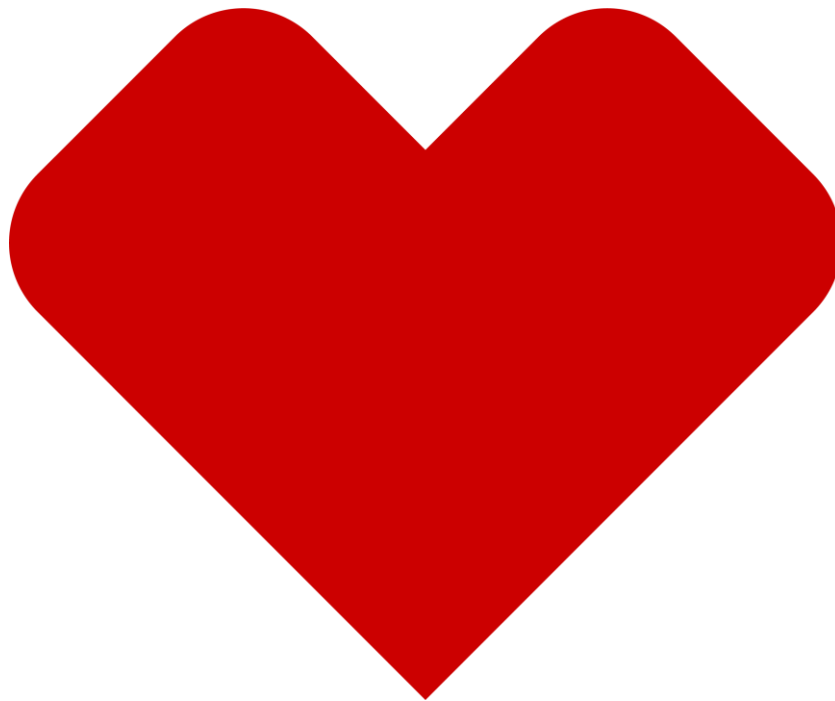

# COVID-19 Testing

Proposal for: **The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania**

Date: 06/16/2020



CVS Health is excited to extend the following offer to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for COVID-19 testing services on behalf of residents and staff members of Long-Term Care facilities (including skilled nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and other segments of the long-term care market). The Onsite Swab & Send solution includes:

- All necessary logistic services, including scheduling, records administration, test orders, and communication of results
- All swab administration
- Transmission to reference laboratory for testing
- All supplies and personal protective equipment
- All necessary reporting to State (to be mutually defined between CVS Health and State).

**Proposal terms:**

- Testing model and fee structure:

Testing Model	Fees	Laboratory Fees

- Anticipated volume of 50,000 tests, with total tests not to exceed 50,000
  - Work to be completed by CVS Pharmacy, Inc., or a subsidiary, including but not limited to Omnicare, Inc., or its subsidiaries and operating entities.
  - State will appoint liaison to assist with identification of target facilities and joint outreach to facilities regarding testing offering
  - CVS Health is committed to expanding testing volume beyond this initial level. CVS Health and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to will work together to align on additional testing volumes throughout the initial engagement
- CVS Health will work with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to provide visibility into forthcoming incremental capacity and the timing when that capacity will

become available (across different testing solution types). It is our hope to be able to accommodate 100% of Pennsylvania's testing requirements within Long-Term Care.

- CVS Health and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will work together to jointly define the locations for testing. Teams will make efforts to consolidate hubs (groups of CVS Health colleagues who will travel to conduct onsite testing activity) into the fewest number of locations possible.
  - PA recognizes that some testing locations may not be viable as part of the CVS Health solution (for example, small-volume facilities that are not co-located in sufficient proximity with other LTC facilities that allow for testing at multiple locations in a single day)
- All invoicing from CVS Health will be conducted through a mutually agreed hard copy format directly submitted to the State through the DGS website portal.
  - Hard copy invoices will be submitted to the State on an aggregated weekly basis
- Data transmission of detailed testing data and results can be transmitted through a mutually agreeable electronic format on a cadence mutually defined

Our proposal is contingent on obtaining appropriate necessary licensure, continuing FDA Emergency Use Authorization for the applicable medical devices, and ongoing federal and state regulatory authority for pharmacists to conduct COVID-19 testing without additional practitioner approval.
